RESOLUTION 84-70S

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE  
HEATH STREET ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY THE  
COMMON COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AND SETTING A  
DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, there is a need for road improvements on Heath Street from the  
By-Pass to Pioneer Avenue as a result of the anticipated development of the  
area;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of  
Homer, that the Council does determine that the improvements are necessary and  
should be made in accordance with HCC 17.04.050 of the Homer City Code; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the City of Homer to  
form such improvement district and that a public hearing will be held during  
the regular City Council meeting of Monday, August 27, 1984 at Homer City  
Hall, at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests to the formation of  
such improvement district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to  
compile the necessary information on the cost of the improvement and to begin  
to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of  
such cost and to have the date of the hearing published as required by law.
