A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PHASE I AND II DUMPING AT THE SPIT CAMPGROUND BE COMPLETED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND THAT THE AFOREMENTIONED AREA BE DESIGNATED OPEN SPACE/RECREATIONAL AS NECESSARY AND COMPATIBLE USES.

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Parks and Recreation Commission has an interest in the development and preservation of the Homer Spit, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has asked the Commission for recommendations on development of the base of the spit campground and those recommendations have been given,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Homer will pursue the following policies concerning the base of the spit campground:

- 1. Phase I and II fill areas, comprising approximately 4.6 acres at the base of the Homer Spit, to be completed as soon as possible;
- The zoning will remain open space/recreational;
- 3. That concise land use planning be utilized to obtain optimum use of the entire area; and
- 4. That the primary use of the area be for wildlife habitat and recreational development, which are compatible uses.
