RESOLUTION 85-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF HOMER REQUESTING LAKE STREET EXTENSION AS THE  
MAIN ACCESS TO THE NEW HOMER HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is currently completing construction of the new Homer High School in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, considerable concern has been expressed as to inadequate pedestrian and vehicular access to the high school; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission, at their regular meeting held March 6, 1985, unanimously recommended that the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities' maintenance building be relocated and Lake Street be extended in order to provide the main access to the new high school complex; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council concurs that Lake Street extended should provide the main access to the new high school rather than Fairview Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Kenai Peninsula Borough be requested to redesign the access and provide sufficient right-of-way across the Department of Transportation's lot located at Lake Street and Pioneer Avenue in order to allow immediate construction of the extension of Lake Street to provide the main access for the new Homer High School complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby instructs Administration to cooperate in this necessary change and is further willing to participate financially in the cost of extending Lake Street to the Homer High School parking lot.
