A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO ADVERTISE THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY PROJECT FOR BIDS.

WHEREAS, the following sources of funds are available for the construction of a new public works facility: per capita \$112,466; federal revenue sharing \$265,534; city budget (82-83) \$60,000; sewer fund (83-84) \$40,000; and water sewer grants \$141,000; and

WHEREAS, \$69,000 has been spent to date for engineering and related costs; and

WHEREAS, \$550,000 is presently available for the purpose of constructing a new public works facility;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 3.16 of the Homer Municipal Code, it is the responsibility of the Common Council of Homer to approve procurement action with an estimated value over \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, purchases or contracts having an estimated value of more than \$15,000 may be made after a notice calling for bids is printed once a week for not less than two consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS, bid/contract specifications have been developed in accordance with Chapter 3.16 of the Homer Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the final plans and specifications for the new public works facility are complete; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the City Manager is authorized to advertise the public works facility project for bids in accordance with the City's procurement procedure.
