RESOLUTION 86-1

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE A STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT KNOWN AS HIGHLAND DRIVE/MOUNTAIN PARK, BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a petition requesting the creation of the Highland Drive LID was received by the City and scheduled for a public hearing on November 25, 1985 via Resolution 85-87; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was postponed due to the excessive high cost associated with the proposed local improvement district; and

WHEREAS, staff has researched a variety of alternatives intended to reduce the cost and has presented a plan acceptable to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Council does determine the petition sufficient to continue the Highland Drive Local Improvement District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a public hearing will be held on Monday, February 10, 1986 at Homer City Hall at 7:30 p.m., for the purpose of hearing objections or comments on the formation of the Highland Drive/Mountain Street Local Improvement District (Plan I).


