RESOLUTION 86-13

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AIRPORT REVIEW COMMITTEE,  
ADVISORY TO THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL, AND PROVIDING FOR THE  
CONDITIONS AND DURATION OF THAT COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation/Public Facilities has  
completed the Homer Airport Master Plan presenting a comprehensive analysis of  
the facility needs and improvements planned for the airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is desirous of studying the feasibility  
of local ownership and operational control of the airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of  
Homer, Alaska that there is hereby established an Airport Review Committee,  
advisory to the Homer City Council, subject to the following conditions:

1. There shall be five (5) members of the Committee, representing  
the community at large with at least one council member chairing the  
Committee. City staff shall be advisory only.

2. Appointment of the Committee is by the Mayor and shall be  
confirmed by the Homer City Council.

3. The Committee shall be delegated authority to review and  
recommend to the Council appropriate action regarding the future of the Homer  
Airport and the role of the City in its operation and maintenance. The  
Committee is expected to utilize the Homer Airport Master Plan as a guideline  
in their work and formulate a recommendation to the Council indicating the  
advantages and disadvantages of the City participating in the operation and/or  
ownership of the Airport as well as anticipated resources required in order to  
accomplish this.


4. The duration of the Committee shall be for a period of four (4)  
months and shall expire July 1, 1986.
