A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
CHANGING THE NAME OF THE HOMER BYPASS ROAD
TO THE STERLING HIGHWAY FROM PIONEER AVENUE
TO LAKE STREET

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council directed the Homer Advisory Planning Commission to rename the Homer Bypass Road; and

WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 85-35 establishes a uniform street naming system within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the said Borough ordinance allows for renaming of streets within the Borough upon notification of adjoining property owners and holding of a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Homer Advisory Planning Commission on February 19, 1986.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the stretch of roadway between Pioneer Avenue and Lake Street commonly known as the Homer Bypass is hereby officially named the Sterling Highway and so designated on the Kenai Peninsula Borough's official street name map.
