A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA CREATING THE STERLING
HIGHWAY WATER AND SEWER SERVICE IMPROVEMENT
AREA AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, there is a need for water and sewer service along the area of the Sterling Highway, and it is in the interest of good health and the general welfare of the public to have a water and sewer system, and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has requested that the City initiate the water and sewer project in order to benefit possible new school construction in this area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Council does determine that the water and sewer improvements are necessary and should be made in accordance with Homer City Code 17.12.030.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing will be held on Monday, June 9, 1986 at the Homer City Hall at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing objections or comments to the formation of such improvement area.


