A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA REQUESTING THAT MONITORING AND STUDYING OF MT. AUGUSTINE BE CONTINUED AT A LEVEL TO ASSURE ADEQUATE PROTECTION.

WHEREAS, the seismic activity of Mt. Augustine is at a high level, and

WHEREAS, the possibility of tsunami is greatly increased with this activity, and

WHEREAS, the population of the City of Homer as well as other communities along the coast of Cook Inlet and Kachemak Bay are threatened by a potential tsunami,


