RESOLUTION 86-36

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF HOMER PERSONNEL REGULATIONS EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION AND REPEALING THE PREVIOUS PERSONNEL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Homer City Council to provide an established set of personnel regulations for all City employees; and

WHEREAS, the personnel regulations may be revised or modified from time to time based on changing conditions and circumstances; and

WHEREAS, enactment of the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act gave cause to review the City of Homer Personnel Regulations; and


WHEREAS, the City of Homer has determined that employees may participate in the State of Alaska, Public Employees Retirement System which required a reduction in leave accrual benefit to the employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, Directors and employees (through the Employee's Benefit Review Committee) have determined that amendments enacted with the adoption of this resolution are in the best interest of the City of Homer and its personnel;


