RESOLUTION 86-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE HOMER SPIT ACTION PLAN, SUMMER 1986 AND APPROPRIATING MONIES NOT TO EXCEED \$6600 TO IMPLEMENT THE PLAN.

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the City of Homer, its residents and its visitor tourists to designate land usage on city owned land on the Homer Spit in order to efficiently manage increase summer activities; and

WHEREAS, a Spit Action Plan for summer, 1986 has been completed designating parking areas, camping areas, staging areas, etc. on city owned land; and


WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed plan was held on April 28, 1986 to hear public comments on the plan; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated to cost approximately \$6600 to implement the Spit Action Plan.


