RESOLUTION 86-39

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO ADOPT CS SENATE BILL 150 IN THE FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE SESSION, SECOND SESSION.

WHEREAS, CS Senate Bill 150 is an act making miscellaneous amendments to the Alaska Water Use Act (AS 46.15) and establishes procedures for administrative and judicial adjudication of water rights under that act; and

WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the City of Homer that adoption of the Senate Bill 150 is necessary in order to settle disputed water rights associated with the Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council respectively request the State Legislature to adopt CS Senate Bill 150, an act making amendments to the Alaska Water Use Act and establishing the procedures for administrative and judicial adjudication of water rights under that act.


