A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER CREATING THE OFFICE OF E.M.S. SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN TO SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COUNCIL, AND APPOINTING DR. BELL TO FILL THAT PUBLIC OFFICE.

WHEREAS, Dr. Bell has for several years acted as supervising physician in the Emergency Medical Services (E.M.S.) program provided by the Homer Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, recent increases in premiums have made it economically prohibitive for Dr. Bell to obtain liability insurance covering his practice as it relates to the E.M.S. program in Homer; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of all parties and the public for Dr. Bell to continue in his capacity as supervising physician of the E.M.S. program; and

WHEREAS, subject to adoption of this Resolution, an agreement has been executed between the City of Homer and Dr. Bell regarding the responsibilities of each party,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Office of E.M.S. Supervising Physician, to serve at the pleasure of the Council, is hereby created and appointing Dr. Bell to this public office.
