A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE UNDER STATE OF ALASKA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE RENOVATION/ EXPANSION OF THE PRATT MUSEUM

WHEREAS, the present facility has limited access for the elderly and disabled, and

WHEREAS, the public has indicated support for this renovation/expansion project through a formal public hearing process in April of 1984, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is committed to promoting access improvement in public facilities in order to assure the involvement of senior citizens and the disabled in community activities, and

WHEREAS, the Pratt Museum provides valuable educational, cultural and recreational programs which enhance the well-being of the community, and

WHEREAS, the Pratt Museum contributes to the economic well-being of the community by providing an important visitor information attraction, and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the Homer Society of Natural History of the City of Homer are applying to the State of Alaska for a Community Development Block Grant, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that requirements be met as part of the application process, and



