RESOLUTION 86-44

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE HOMER HARBOR EXPANSION, ENGINEERING CONTRACT TO PERATROVICH, NOTTINGHAM & DRAGE, INC., IN THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$100,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council authorized engineering services by the firm of Peratrovich, Nottingham and Drage, Inc. at their regular meeting held March 10, 1986; and

WHEREAS, additions to the Homer Harbor Expansion Project for permitting, dredging and construction inspection were necessary, and

WHEREAS, the Council has awarded a contract for the expansion of floats in the Homer Small Boat Harbor, and


WHEREAS, costs for these services are broken down as follows:

I.	Dredging Design & Contract Documents	\$15,000
II.	Re-Permitting & Coordination	\$10,000
III.	Float Plant Inspection	\$25,000
IV.	Shop Drawings & Coordination	\$20,000
V.	Field Consultation	\$30,000
VI.	TOTAL	\$100,000


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the additional engineering services contract for the Homer Harbor Expansion Project be awarded in the amount not to exceed \$100,000 based upon cost of time and materials submitted by the firm of Peratrovich, Nottingham & Drage, Inc., and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
