A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A REQUEST TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT/PF) TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE EAST HILL ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that numerous advantages are available to the Homer area with direct participation by the City in reconstruction of East Hill Road Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer wishes to assume local responsibility over the project utilizing construction management assistance; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 35.15.080 provides for a Transfer of Responsibility Agreement (TORA) allowing the City to assume responsibility for bidding, construction and construction management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a request to DOT/PF to assume responsibility for the East Hill Road Project bidding, construction and construction management through a Transfer of Responsibility Agreement (TORA) subject to state funding of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to prepare a Request for Proposal for project management of the East Hill Road Reconstruction Project.
