RESOLUTION 86-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING THE APPOINTMENT OF A RESIDENT ACTING DISTRICT COURT JUDGE BY THE ALASKA COURT SYSTEM AS AN INTERIM REPLACEMENT FOR JUDGE JAMES C. HORNADAY.

WHEREAS, District Court Judge James C. Hornaday is taking a one year sabbatical from his job in Homer, Alaska, effective August, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer and its immediate surrounding area has consistently grown over the past four years and the lack of a resident judge would detrimentally affect the Homer community, especially in light of increased activity in the area due to the Bradley Lake Hydro-electric Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer desires to have a resident judge located in Homer during the absence of Judge James C. Hornaday,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA that the City of Homer supports and encourages the appointment of a resident Acting District Court Judge by the Alaska Court System as an interim replacement for Judge James C. Hornaday.
