A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER AWARDING THE INFLUENT PUMP STATION PROJECT TO THE FIRM OF SWALLING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. IN THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$209,786 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer held a public bid opening for the Influent Pump Station Project on September 5, 1986 at 2:00 p.m. at the Homer City Hall, and;

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was the firm of Swalling Construction Company, Inc., and;


WHEREAS, the bid is broken down as follows:

I.	All work not included in Items 2 & 3	\$208,436.
II.	Imported selected backfill material for pipe zone material	\$750.
III.	Imported trench stabilization material	\$600.
IV.	TOTAL BID SCHEDULE:	\$209,786.


