A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
CHANGING THE CITY OF HOMER'S FISCAL YEAR
FROM THE 12 MONTH PERIOD COMMENCING JULY 1
THROUGH JUNE 30TH OF THE SUCCEEDING YEAR TO
THE 12 MONTH PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1
THROUGH DECEMBER 31ST OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

WHEREAS, public access and participation in various City activities such as budget preparation, capital improvement planning, and utility and port and harbor rate setting would be improved under a calendar year format; and

WHEREAS, the calendar year format would enable City departments to balance their workload more evenly throughout the year; and


WHEREAS, State funding levels should be known prior to adopting annual budgets under a calendar year format; and

WHEREAS, scheduling of capital improvement planning and capital budget process would be improved under the calendar year format.



