RESOLUTION 86-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO APPOINT A REPLACEMENT FOR TOM BROWN WITH SOMEONE LIVING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF HOMER.

WHEREAS, Proposition 4 was duly approved by the voters of District 4 to recall Assembly Member Tom Brown during the General Municipal Election held October 7, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statutes provide that if a majority vote favors recall, the office becomes vacant upon certification of the recall election; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly may appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy to serve until the next regular election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that:

Section 1. The Homer City Council hereby requests that the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly appoint a replacement for Assembly Member Brown from those eligible living within the corporate limits of the City of Homer.

Section 2. The Homer City Council members are encouraged to suggest eligible applicants to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk and Assembly Members.

Section 3. Copies of this resolution shall be immediately forwarded to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor Stan Thompson and each member of the Borough Assembly.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
