RESOLUTION 86-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HOMER ADOPTING CAPITAL
PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 1988.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held October 13, 1986 in order to obtain comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1988 capital improvement priorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intend of the City Council to provide the Governor and legislative delegation from District 5 adequate information to represent the desires of the City concerning legislative requests including necessary funding requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the following Capital Improvement Projects are identified as the City of Homer priority list for Legislative Request in Fiscal Year 1988:

1. Sewer Treatment Plant Expansion - Phase II	\$ 4,920,000
2. Main Dock Repairs	627,000
3. Fire Tanker/Pumper Truck & Equipment	240,000
4. Spit Outfall Line	490,000
5. Ferry Terminal Upgrade	2,275,000
6. Fairview Avenue Construction - Phase I	350,000
7. Heath Street Construction - Phase II	265,000
8. Spit Waterline Replacement - Phase II	972,400
9. Harbor Floats - Phase II	2,000,000
10. Homer East End Road Water Tie-In	249,400
11. Homer Library Expansion - Design	71,000
12. Fire Department Rescue Truck	140,000

AREAWIDE PROJECTS

1. Pratt Museum Expansion	\$ 350,000
2. Homer Community College Renovation	340,000
3. KBBI Public Radio Station Relocation	172,700
4. South Peninsula Hospital X-Ray Equipment	427,000
