A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE ELECTRICAL BID FOR THE HOMER HARBOR EXPANSION PROJECT TO HERNDON & HERNDON, INC. IN THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$408,070 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer did duly and properly advertise for the supply and installation of (5) high mast light units and installation of an electrical system for the proposal Float System 5 of the Homer Small Boat Harbor Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer held a public bid opening on October 31, 1986 at 3:00 p.m. at Homer City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was the firm of Herndon & Herndon; and



WHEREAS, the bid is broken down as follows:

	Total Basic Bid	\$408,070


