## RESOLUTION 86-83

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SALES TAX COMMITTEE, ADVISORY TO THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL, AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONDITIONS AND DURATION OF THAT COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, building and maintaining safe, efficient and reliable streets is one of the most important responsibilities of local government; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has determined that it is desirable to study the feasibility of a local bond issue financed by sales tax receipts to construct and reconstruct streets to an acceptable standard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer. Alaska that there is hereby established a Sales Tax Committee, advisory to the Homer City Council, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. There shall be five (5) members of the Committee determined by the Mayor who represent the community at large. Necessary city staff shall only be advisory to the committee.
- 2. The Committee shall be delegated the authority to review. revise and/or recommend appropriate means of implementing a bond issue supported by a sales tax for street construction and reconstruction.
- 3. The Committee may select necessary professional services to perform work outlined by the Committee, subject to the approval of the Homer City Manager.
- 4. The duration of the Committee shall be for a period of five (5) months and shall expire March 31, 1987. The Committee is expected to present to the City Council. in final form, a recommendation regarding a bond issue for street construction and reconstruction within the City of Homer as well as appropriate financing.
