RESOLUTION 86-84

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO REVIEW REQUEST  
FOR STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATION AND INTEREST FOR PORT AND  
HARBOR DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer seeks to develop its Port/Harbor to provide an environment conducive to the establishment/operation of various types of businesses and/or activities; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested Statements of Qualification and Interest from firms to provide assistance in the planning, design and development of various city-owned properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that there is hereby established a Port/Harbor Development Committee, advisory to the Homer City Council, selected to review Statements of Qualifications and Interest for Port and Harbor Development Assistance, subject to the following conditions:

1. There shall be five (5) members of the Committee determined by the Mayor including one representative from the Port and Harbor Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, Planning Commission, Economic Development Steering Committee and the City Council. Necessary city staff shall be advisory only to the Committee.


2. The Committee shall be delegated the authority to evaluate and rank responses to the City of Homer Request for Statement of Qualifications and Interest for Port and Harbor Development Assistance as advertised by the City on August 28, 1986.

3. The Committee may select necessary professional services to perform work outlined by the Committee, subject to the approval of the Homer City Manager.


4. The duration of the Committee shall be for a period of three (3) months and shall expire February 28, 1987. The Committee is expected to present to the City Council a recommendation regarding development proposals for the Homer Port and Harbor.
