A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE WEST HILL ROAD/STERLING HIGHWAY WATER/SEWER SERVICE IMPROVEMENT AREA AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, there is a need for sewer service on W. Hill Road/Sterling Highway, and it is in the interest of good health and the general welfare of the public to have a sewer system, and

WHEREAS, staff intends to hold townhouse meetings with property owners in the W. Hill Road/Sterling Highway area to discuss possible boundaries for the project and obtain input from the property owners prior to public hearing,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Council does determine that the water/sewer improvements are necessary and should be made in accordance with HCC 17.04.050.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the City of Homer to form such an improvement area and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, March 9, 1986 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to compile the necessary information, boundaries, and cost of the improvement and to begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of such cost and the date of the hearing publicized as required by law.
