RESOLUTION 86-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER
REQUESTING EXTENSION OF THE COMMENT PERIOD REGARDING
PROPOSED OFFSHORE PROSPECTING PERMITS IN COOK INLET.

WHEREAS, interest has been expressed by industry for carrying out
gold exploration on the sea floor of lower Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of
Mining and Geology, has given notice under AS 38.05.945(a) (3) of a publication
of Supplemental Preliminary Best Interest Finding and Consistency
Determination regarding the proposed issuance of offshore prospecting permits
in Cook Inlet with such comments to be received by January 9, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has been advised that this matter
requires additional review and study before making a determination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the
Alaska Department of Natural Resources is hereby respectfully requested to
grant an extension of time for review and comment to June 1, 1987 in order to
better evaluate the consequences of such a proposed offshore prospecting
permits in Cook Inlet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution shall be
forwarded to the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Mining and
Geology; Governor Steve Cowper; Senator Paul Fischer;
Representative C. E. Swackhammer; Representative Mike Navarre; Borough Mayor
Stan Thompson; Borough Assembly Members Gail Phillips, Brent Keene, and Marie
Wallie; and the Homer Chamber of Commerce.
