A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE HOMER SPIT OUTFALL PROJECT

WHEREAS, at the present time, no municipal sewer system exists on the Homer Spit, and

WHEREAS, human waste, and effluent generated from other Spit activities are being discharged into septic systems which may create a public health hazard, and

WHEREAS, the installation of a Spit outfall line will be a first step in improving a potential public health hazard, and

WHEREAS, the public has indicated support for this project through the Capital Improvement public hearing process in October and November of 1986, and


WHEREAS, the installation of a Spit outfall line will create jobs and enhance economic development, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer recently passed Resolution 87-9A authorizing a bond issue for \$1,030,000 for the Homer sewer system which includes matching funds for the proposed project, and



WHEREAS, the City of Homer is applying to the State of Alaska for a Community Development Block Grant.
