RESOLUTION 87-22(S)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING \$22,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA AND AGREEING TO FURNISH AND INSTALL THE HOMER MIDDLE SCHOOL FLASHER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the legislature, under Chpater 130 SAL 1986 page 98, line 26, has appropriated, authorized and funded monies to the Department of Transportation for the installation of a flasher system for the Homer Middle School on the Sterling Highway; and

WHEREAS, all bids received by the Department of Transporation for the flasher system exceeded the amount funded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer has requested that the \$22,000 remaining in project funds be transferred to the City of Homer in order that the City can use these funds for the planning and construction of the flasher system; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has agreed to transfer \$22,000 to the City of Homer conditioned upon the City of Homer agreeing to insure that the system is installed in 1987, that the installation will be complete construction, inspection, project management and related costs and that construction will be done to all State of Alaska and City of Homer codes; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has agreed to assume operation and maintenance of the flasher system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the City Manager be authorized to sign the transfer of responsibility agreement and to accept the \$22,000 for the Homer Middle School flasher system.
