A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER CHANGING THE CITY COUNCIL AGENDA DEADLINE TO 8:00 A.M. TUESDAYS THE WEEK PRIOR TO REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING AND SETTING INFORMATIONAL PACKET AVAILABILITY TO WEDNESDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has expressed their concern over not having enough review time of packet materials before the regular Monday night Council meetings, and

WHEREAS, by setting the agenda deadline to Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. on the week prior to the regular meeting, will give staff time to prepare the informational packet and also add items of business that may surface at Council worksessions which are held on opposite Mondays of the Council meeting, and

WHEREAS, by making packets available to the Council on Wednesdays at 5:00 p.m. will give Councilmembers two extra working days to contact staff with questions and research information contained in the packet;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that City Council Agenda deadline is set for 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday mornings preceding the regular City Council meeting and having informational packets available no later than Wednesday at 5:00 p.m. prior to the meeting.
