RESOLUTION 87-27(s)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING PREPARATION, RECORDING AND ADOPTION OF THE 1987 CITY OF HOMER ALIQUOT MONUMENT SURVEY MAPS AS THE STANDARD BASIS BY WHICH ALL UTILITIES, STREETS, AND PROPERTY SURVEY CORNERS SHALL BE ESTABLISHED, LOCATED AND PERPETUATED THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the primary importance of a city controlled survey is to provide established control monumentation throughout the city for all future property corners, streets and road control monuments as well as utility locations utilizing the same grid coordinate system; and

WHEREAS, the recently adopted Road Standards Ordinance requires all newly constructed roads and streets to be monumented based upon City of Homer grid coordinates; and

WHEREAS, the 1977 City Control Survey only encompasses the city core and is not sufficient to provide the necessary control system in the remaining areas of the city; and


WHEREAS, in order to provide a city wide official grid system for the monumentation, it is necessary to draft an entirely new set of maps showing the description, coordinate position and designation of all aliquot monuments and other major control monuments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby adopts the 1977 City Control Survey as the standard basis by which all utilities and lot corners shall be located and perpetuated throughout the city.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to have prepared a final set of 1987 City of Homer Aliquot Monument Survey Maps and cause recording of same by Ability Surveys at a cost not to exceed \$4600.
