A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE HOUSE BUDGET AGREEMENT RESTORING BUDGET CUTS TO SCHOOL DEBT SERVICE, REVENUE SHARING AND MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Governor is proposing to cut the budget for school debt, revenue sharing and municipal assistance by twenty percent for FY88; and

WHEREAS, reduced funding for municipalities will result in either increased local property taxes or reduced local services; and


WHEREAS, the House Budget Agreement will put school debt service, municipal assistance, and municipal revenue sharing all at a level of ninety percent of their 1987 revised levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby supports the House Budget Agreement to put school debt service, municipal assistance and municipal revenue sharing all at a level of ninety percent of their 1987 revised levels.


