WHEREAS, the City Council desires to keep close contact with its own financial status due to the economic situation, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to assure that costs of government be reviewed to ascertain that the costs are necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common City Council of Homer, Alaska that City Council:

- 1. Review the City budget on a quarterly basis.
- 2. Have the adminstration immediatley review the personnel & cost involved in departments which are affected by seasonal construction work.
- 3. Adopt A "freeze" policy on <u>all</u> City positions which are vacated.
- 4. Have the administration review the need to maintain the position, and submit its findings to the Council for action.
