RESOLUTION 87- 38

WHEREAS, THE ECONOMY OF THE State of Alaska is declining and the revenues of the State are declining, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is affected by these state declines as well as potentially facing a declining economy in our own area, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to keep close contact with its own financial status due to the economic situation, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to assure that costs of government be reviewed to ascertain that the costs are necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common City Council of Homer, Alaska that City Council:

1. Review the City budget on a quarterly basis.
2. Have the administration immediately review the personnel & cost involved in departments which are affected by seasonal construction work.
3. Adopt A "freeze" policy on all City positions which are vacated.
4. Have the administration review the need to maintain the position, and submit its findings to the Council for action.
