## RESOLUTION 87-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION OF PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION TO CONSIDER EXISTING AND FUTURE PLANS TO DEVELOP A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AND CAMPER PARK ON STATE OWNED PROPERTY IN THE BAYCREST HILL AREA.

WHEREAS, the State does not currently have a recreational vehicle park on the southern end of the Kenai Peninsula attached to the road system; and

WHEREAS, the State owns property in the Baycrest Hill area with plans to develop a tourist contact facility and parking; and

WHEREAS, a recreational vehicle park would be a major benefit to the community and to the State by alleviating parking and congestion at the end of the Spit; and

WHEREAS, the development of a recreational vehicle park in Homer is consistent with the State's efforts to promote tourism in Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council does hereby urge the State to consider existing and future plans to develop a recreational vehicle and camper park in the Baycrest Hill area.
