RESOLUTION 87-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO EXPEDITE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ALASKA HIRE LAW TO AFFECT CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE II OF THE BRADLEY LAKE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in 1986 the Alaska Hire Law (HB266, SB 367) took effect, and

WHEREAS, this law directs the Department of Labor to do research and analysis to determine regulations which can be developed to require more local hire on State funded construction projects, and in the private sector, and to hold statewide public hearings on the matter, and

WHEREAS, Phase II of the Bradley Lake Project is the greatest opportunity for local workers of any of the project phases, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council urges the Department of Labor to expedite implementation of the Alaska Hire Law to affect construction of the Bradley Lake Project, and


