NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Sterling Highway Water & Sewer Main Line Extension Contruction contract be awarded to the firm of Herndon & Herndon, Inc., in the total amount of \$615,973.50, and authorizing the City Manager to sign the appropriate documents.
