A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE STERLING HIGHWAY WATER AND SEWER MAIN LINE EXTENSION CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO HERNDON & HERNDON, INC. IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$615,973.50 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council authorized the formation of the Sterling Highway Water/Sewer Improvement area and authorized the City Manager to proceed with the preparation and construction of the project via Resolution 86-71, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer did duly and properly advertise for bids between July 9 - July 15, 1987, and

WHEREAS, a public bid opening was held on July 30, 1987 at 2:00 p.m. at Homer City Hall, and


WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bidder was the construction firm of Herndon & Herndon, Inc. with a bid breakdown as follows:

I.	Basic Bid	\$398,173.50
II.	Added Alternates	\$217,800.
	TOTAL I & II	\$615,973.50


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Sterling Highway Water & Sewer Main Line Extension Construction contract be awarded to the firm of Herndon & Herndon, Inc., in the total amount of \$615,973.50, and authorizing the City Manager to sign the appropriate documents.
