A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held September 28, 1987 in order to obtain comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1989 capital improvement priorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor and legislative delegation from District 5 adequate information to represent the desires of the City concerning legislative requests including necessary funding requirements.


