RESOLUTION 87-78

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME TO BROADEN CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSAL #7 TO INCORPORATE THE ORIGINAL INTENT OF RESOLUTION 85-82; OR ALTERNATELY TO OPEN THE NEXT BOARD OF GAME MEETING TO CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS INCLUDING AREAS CLOSED TO HUNTING.

WHEREAS, the Board of Game has the authority to regulate hunting and trapping within the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Homer has previously found in Resolution 85-82 that closing the corporate limits of the City of Homer to all hunting, and to trapping by means of a firearm, is in the public interest of the City of Homer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Game is now considering action on Regulatory Proposal #7; closing the corporate limits of Homer to trapping by means of a firearm; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Homer has been attempting to bring these regulatory changes before the Board for several years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that the Alaska Board of Game be requested to broaden their consideration, of Proposal #7 to include prohibition of all hunting within the corporate limits of the City of Homer; or, alternately that the Board of Game open their next meeting to include acceptance of proposals addressing areas closed to hunting, at which time the Board is requested to consider and adopt our proposed closed area.
