OF CITY BUSINESS.


WHEREAS, in recent years, the number of lawsuits in
which officials and employees of the City are personally named as
defendants has proliferated; and

WHEREAS, City officials and employees should be
protected from personal liability resulting from their actions or
omissions taken in good faith and in the course of City business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer
hereby indemnifies and holds harmless all elected and appointed
officials and employees of the City, including members of boards
and commissions who, at the time they have been named defendants
in any lawsuit, were acting in good faith and in the course and
furtherance of City business.
