WHEREAS, the Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association is the regional aquaculture association for the entire Cook Inlet area, and



WHEREAS, the City of Homer has an opportunity to fill a representative-at-large seat on the Board of Directors of the Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association.


