Superior court filings from the trial court located in Homer to the Kenai
Court, and;


WHEREAS, such action would cause a significant inconvenience and
additional expense to the citizens and residents of the City as well as the
entire Southern Kenai Peninsula, and;

WHEREAS, the transfer of filings would have the effect of down grading the
Homer Court Facility which in fact has shown a dramatic increase in case load in
recent years;


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Homer City Council strongly opposes the
