A RESOLUTION OF HOMER CITY COUNCIL OPPOSING THE TRANSFER OF COURT FILINGS FROM THE HOMER TRIAL COURT TO THE COURT IN KENAI.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Court System is considering the transfer of all Superior court filings from the trial court located in Homer to the Kenai Court, and;

WHEREAS, such action would cause a significant inconvenience and additional expense to the citizens and residents of the City as well as the entire Southern Kenai Peninsula, and;

WHEREAS, the transfer of filings would have the effect of down grading the Homer Court Facility which in fact has shown a dramatic increase in case load in recent years;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Homer City Council strongly opposes the transfer of Court filings from the Homer Trial Court to the court facility at Kenai and respectfully requests the Alaska Court System to maintain or up grade the trial court at Homer.
