RESOLUTION 88-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT BID TO ALL SEASONS HONDA AND SKIDOO IN THE AMOUNT OF \$119,281 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is required by the State of Alaska to provide adequate fire protection for the Homer Small Boat Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public bid opening for necessary fire fighting equipment for the Homer Small Boat Harbor on December 10, 1987 at 2 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by All Seasons Honda and Skidoo in the following amounts:

Bid Price for Four (4) Wheeled Fire Fighting Carts:	\$57,708
Bid Price for Three (3) Track Fire Fighting Carts:	\$47,436
Bid Price for One (1) Skid Mount System:	<u>\$14,137</u>
TOTAL	\$119,281



WHEREAS, the necessary funding is available from previously obtained harbor construction state grant funds.


