A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING AN OPTION FOR THE MAYOR'S  
POSITION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CITY'S GROUP  
BENEFIT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, numerous local governments provide  
compensation and/or insurance benefits to elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's position for the City of Homer  
provides a minimal stipend and allows participation in the Public  
Employees Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, participants in the Public Employees  
Retirement System are entitled to certain rights and protection  
under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974  
(ERISA); and


WHEREAS, such benefits would extend the life, dental,  
health and vision group benefits on an optional basis but would  
not provide the weekly indemnity benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City  
Council that the Mayor's position is entitled to an option of  
participating in the City of Homer Group Benefit Program,  
provided the Mayor pays the premium.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney is hereby
