RESOLUTION 88-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
SUPPORTING THE SOUTH PENINSULA LITTLE LEAGUE.

WHEREAS, the Homer area is one of baseball and softball enthusiasts; and

WHEREAS, there is a definite need for additional ball fields within the area; and

WHEREAS, a continued regularly scheduled Little League Program for our youngsters should be encouraged; and

WHEREAS, this activity requires a location designated with regulation ball fields; and

WHEREAS, the existing fields located at Karen Hornaday Park are controlled by the City of Homer in conjunction with the Kenai Peninsula Community Schools; and

WHEREAS, the existing facility is being used by an increasing number of adult softball leagues plus other scheduled users and tourists; and

WHEREAS, the existing facility cannot be enlarged to accommodate the increased demands; and


WHEREAS, there is no other location within the area that is designated as a ball park; and

WHEREAS, the South Peninsula Little League, a nonprofit organization recognized by the State of Alaska, has undertaken to organize, establish, control and maintain a multi-use ball park for the benefit of all area residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council supports the South Peninsula Little League in its efforts to locate, establish and maintain a multi-use ball park for the benefit of all youngsters residing in and around the City of Homer.
