RESOLUTION 88-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE A WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR A PORTION OF JENNY LANE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PLAN, AND NOTIFY AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS IN THIS DISTRICT AND SETTING PUBLIC HEARING ON THE WATER IMPROVEMENT FOR NOVEMBER 28, 1988.

WHEREAS, the property owners along Jenny Lane have petitioned for a road reconstruction improvement district and paving has recently been added to the improvement district; and

WHEREAS, a water line extends from Olsen Lane down Jenny Lane for only a portion of the road;

WHEREAS, extension of a water line to the end of Jenny Lane will promote the health, safety, convenience and welfare of the property owners of Jenny Lane; and

WHEREAS, extending the water line prior to road reconstruction and paving is prudent and beneficial to the property owners of Jenny Lane;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Jenny Lane Water Line Extension Improvement District is hereby created and that the City Manager is authorized to complete a water extension improvement plan and notify the property owners of the costs associated with the project;


