A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE DOCUMENT "CITY OF HOMER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM 1989 THROUGH 1994" AS THE OFFICIAL FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN FOR THE CITY OF HOMER.

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) is a long term guide for capital expenditures, and

WHEREAS, a CIP represents projects desired by the community and estimates the effect of each project on the municipal budget and local taxes, and

WHEREAS, the City intends to use the CIP as a guide for capital expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer CIP process has involved consideration of existing plans, programmatic needs, and public input, and

WHEREAS, the CIP process has also involved a public nomination and comment process, and,

WHEREAS, the CIP compliments the City Budget and Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council held the CIP public hearing on September 26, 1988, and in addition to public input received input from the Planning, Port and Harbor and Parks and Recreation Commissions.


