

RESOLUTION 88-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER FINDING THAT THERE IS A NEED TO CREATE A ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR CAMPGROUND ROAD, WAIVING PUBLIC HEARING ON THE NECESSITY OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, reconstruction of Campground road is of benefit to all citizens of the City of Homer, and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is the sole owner of Karen A. Hornaday Hillside Park and the road therein for public recreational purposes, and

WHEREAS, Camground Road is listed as a Group I within the Accelerated Roads Program for reconstruction - strip paving;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council has determined that a road improvement district for Campground Road within the Karen A. Hornaday Hillside Park, is needed and hereby creates a road reconstruction improvement district for Campground Road, authorizing the City Manager to proceed with the preparations and reconstruction of Campground road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that public hearing and objection is hereby waived since the City of Homer is the sole property owner in the district and reconstructs the road as a benefit to all citizens of Homer.
