RESOLUTION 88-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AMENDING ARTICLE 5.8 PAVING REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF HOMER DESIGN CRITERIA MANUAL FOR STREETS AND STORM DRAINAGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer Design Criteria Manual for Streets and Storage Drainage may be revised or modified from time to time based on changing conditions and circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the current Design Criteria Manual for streets and storm drainage requires that paving cannot be done until the street has completed two complete freeze-thaw cycles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, City Manager and Department of Public Works have determined that the attached amendment is necessary so that a road constructed or reconstructed using a minimum of 24-inches of specification crushed rock overlaying an approved geotextile fabric and incorporating an approved geogrid base reinforcement, be paved after the street has completed one complete freeze-thaw cycle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the attached amendment to the Homer Road Standards Criteria Manual outlined in Memorandum dated October 19, 1988 is hereby adopted by reference effective immediately and that the City Manager shall cause the necessary revisions to be incorporated into the existing Road Standards Criteria Manual.
